EUROPEAN HEALTH CARD

TARJETA SANITARIA EUROPEA (TSE)



The **European Health Card** is a document giving you access to medically necessary, state-provided healthcare during a **temporary stay** in any of the 27 EU countries (Germany, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Denmark, Slovakia, Slovenia, Estonia, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Letonia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Czech Republic, Romania, Sweden and Spain), Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland. You must request this card in your home country **before travelling to Spain**.

However, the European Health Card is not valid if you move your residence to another country permanently. If you work in Spain you must be insured under the *Social Security System* and be entitled to health coverage, along with the beneficiaries (spouse or partner and children under 26). To have health assistance in Navarra you should apply for **TARJETA INDIVIDUAL SANITARIA (TIS)** (more info in page 2).

Ascendants are not entitled to health coverage.

DOCUMENTS to be ATTACHED:

- Copy of NIE or Passport.
- Document of address registration (empadronamiento) issued by the city council max 15 days before the TIS application.
- Document proving family relationship for minor children.

STEPS TO FOLLOW

- If the application is correct, the Health Card will be sent to your address in 2 months's time.
- A General Practitioner will be assigned in the Health Centre nearest to your home.
- If you do not give proof of your address, it will be requested in 1 month.
- If you do not meet the requirements you will be informed in 1 month.
